

Skating Club of North Carolina Membership Categories

Family Membership: This membership category is the best category for families with more than one skater. Each Family member is registered with the USFSA and will receive a USFSA number, your household will receive one subscription to *Skating* magazine, your family members can purchase club ice, take USFSA tests, compete in USFSA competitions and take part in SCNC exhibitions. Each family will have one vote at SCNC general membership meetings.

Junior Membership: This category is specifically for skaters under eighteen years of age. All junior members are required to have a parent or guardian join with them. The Junior skater and parent/guardian are registered with USFSA and will receive one subscription to *Skating* magazine. The Junior skater can purchase club ice take USFSA tests, compete in USFSA competitions, and take part in SCNC exhibitions. The parent member receives no skating privileges. The Parent of the Junior membership receives one vote at SCNC general membership meetings.

Senior Membership: This category is for skaters over 18 years old. The Senior skater will receive full club privileges, including one vote at all SCNC general membership meetings, registration with the USFSA, *Skating* magazine, the opportunity to purchase club ice, take USFSA tests, compete in USFSA competitions and take part in SCNC exhibitions.

Collegiate Membership: The Collegiate Membership is offered for skaters that are full time students at the time of their registration with SCNC. The Collegiate member will receive full club privileges, including one vote at all SCNC general membership meetings, registration with the USFSA, *Skating* magazine, the opportunity to purchase club ice, take USFSA tests, compete in USFSA competitions and take part in SCNC exhibitions. Effective 7/1/09, the Collegiate Membership is a one time fee for four years.

Introductory Membership: This membership category is available for skaters currently enrolled in skate school, and that have not yet taken the first applicable USFSA test. The Introductory skater will be registered with USFSA and will receive one subscription to *Skating* magazine. The Introductory member can purchase club ice, take USFSA tests, compete in USFSA competitions, and take part in SCNC exhibitions. Introductory membership receives no vote at SCNC general membership meetings.

Associate Membership: This membership category is only available to skaters currently home club members of another club but who also wish to join SCNC. Associate members have the opportunity to purchase club ice, take USFSA tests at club prices, and participate in SCNC carnivals and exhibitions with written permission from their home club. Associate memberships do not have a vote at SCNC general membership meetings.
